This proto-slasher from director Mario Bava is full of scheming, ulterior motives and striking scenes of violence.



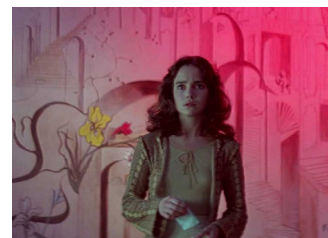
For Night Will Come
