

# Camilla Løw

## Straight Letters

### Exhibition

DCA is proud to be able to show a new sculptural exhibition developed for our galleries. Born in Oslo in 1976, Camilla Løw studied at Glasgow School of Art and, having lived in San Francisco, is now back again in her native Norway, where she has just received the prestigious Statoil Grant Prize for the country's best emerging artist.

Løw's sculptures transcend traditional modes of display – works are clustered, stacked, suspended or leant against the wall. They combine a seemingly casual presentation with heavily refined, tightly crafted and considered use of colour, surface and form. Camilla's playful yet rigorous response to the legacy of Constructivism and Minimalism make for enigmatic geometric riddles that will transform DCA's space.

Newly commissioned works using cast concrete created in Dundee will be presented alongside works in wood and perspex. Always working within a modest human scale, this exhibition represents the first opportunity for the artist and the audience to experience her work in such an expansive environment. As Camilla developed her artistic style in Scotland, the exhibition represents a particularly important milestone for her.

A limited edition print by the artist is being produced at DCA and will be available from the shop. A full colour publication is also in

preparation. Designed by Robert Johnston with new texts on the artist by Michael Archer, Dr Sarah Lowndes and Judith Winter, the catalogue documents the installation alongside important works from the last five years and will be available later in the run of the exhibition.

Recent solo exhibitions include *Broken Windows*, Elastic, Malmo (2007), Sutton Lane, Paris (2006) and Jack Hanley, San Francisco (2005). Significant recent group exhibitions include *Statoil Grant Prize*, Oslo and *Language of Vision*, Mima, Middlesbrough.
